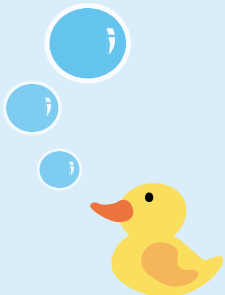

Write down or draw something about what you did together, e.g:

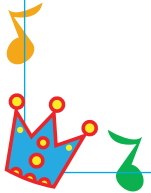
- Where was the bear hidden? Your child could draw a picture of the bear hiding, **or**

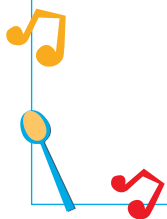

Write down or draw something about what you did together, e.g:

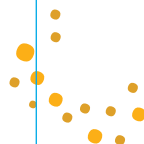
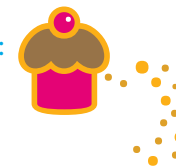
- What did you make instruments out of or how did you make sounds outside?, **or**

# Space

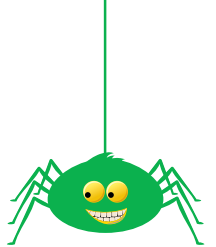
